Information & Policies

TRANSPORTATION

Campers will be picked up at their club site on Sunday and return home on Friday. Camp Fire staff will contact you prior to your week at camp with the pick-up times for the week. An authorized adult must accompany your camper to meet staff at transportation on both days.

CAMP STORE INFORMATION

All campers will have the opportunity to purchase snacks and merchandise from the camp store. Camp Fire club to camp campers will have \$5 in their store account - provided by Camp Fire under the scholarship. If you'd like to add more to your camper's account contact us.

CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CLUB FAMILIES

Camp Fire provides camp scholarships (camperships) to all our club participants. Other families who have a financial need may also apply. Our sessions fill-up quickly; we strongly urge families to register early and no later than May 1. Registration requires a completed registration form turned into your club leader.

ADDITIONAL CAMP SESSIONS/SCHOLARSHIPS

Each club participant is offered one camp session. Additional sessions will be offered as opportunities are available. Camp Fire will contact families if we are able to offer additional scholarships.

REQUIRED HEALTH RECORDS

Health forms and immunization records for each camper are required for all campers to attend Tanadoona. If you have questions while completing your forms or need to find out how to obtain immunization records contact Camp Fire.
