VERTEBRATES VS. INVERTEBRATES

Animals that are made up of bones are called vertebrates. The human body contains between 206-213 bones, and the exact number is different for each animal species.

The vertebrate with the most bones is the python. These giant snakes can be over 20 feet long, and they have 1800 bones in their bodies!


However, some animals have no bones at all! These boneless creatures are called invertebrates. Some famous examples of invertebrates are earthworms, octopi, and even sharks!

Pythons: 1800 Bones




Sharks: 0 Bones










Cranium Crossword

Down:


