Primary Responsibilities

Programs Facilitation & Quality:

- Facilitate environmental education field trips/in-class program, After-school programs, and/or School Break Camps as a part of the programs team.
- Participate in team meetings and support weekly preparation of all necessary program materials.
- Engage in training on environmental education, youth development, risk management, trauma informed care, program facilitation, restorative practices, etc.

Custodial & Maintenance duties:

- Cleaning of buildings and common areas
- Snow removal
- Other duties as assigned

Event/Rental Support:

- Help to ensure facilities and outdoor areas are clean, set-up appropriately, and ready for guest arrival
- Check-in customer upon arrival, answer any questions or concerns and check-out customer upon departure
- · Available to answer any questions. Troubleshoot and support with AV, technology, grounds, and other venue needs

- Calm and an effective problem solver

- Previous experience in youth work, environmental education or related fields if scheduled for youth programs

- Able to work both indoors and outdoors year-round in all type of weather
- First Aid and CPR, ARC Lifequard certifications or experience is a plus, but not required

- Most programming occurs Monday-Friday during the day.
